## This weekend, it's Feast & Fiddle at St. Louis Parish!

### St. Louis Feast Day

#### Odpust Sw. Ludwika

Come and join the parishioners at St. Louis Parish for the celebration of St. Louis' Feast Day, starting at 4 p.m. this Sunday, August 30 at St. Louis Parish (279 Danforth St, Portland). There will be authentic Polish Food, accompanied by a lottery with fabulous prizes.

#### The Don Roy Trio performs

At 6:30 p.m., after the feast, the **Don Roy Trio** will perform, so get your dancing shoes ready. No admission, but donations are more than welcomed. The suggested donation is \$10.

The musical duo of Don and Cindy Roy have been at the forefront of the Franco American community in the greater Portland area. Don directed the popular Maine French Fiddlers for many years. Together they have long entertained audiences in the Southern Maine area and beyond. Upright bass player Jay Young has been playing with Don and Cindy for many years as well.

Don Roy is a champion with depth in many styles of fiddling. Hailing from roots deep in the Maritimes and Quebec, the Roy's musical passion lies with the French Canadian tradition followed closely by Celtic music.

Cindy, also a member of the former Maine French Fiddlers, is well known for her step dancing piano accompaniment which is among the best in New England. Augmented by her rhythmic feet, she adds life and enthusiasm to the music.

Jay Young plays upright bass with the group. Jay began his musical evolution playing folk music on a 12 string guitar in the 1960's. He slid into playing electric guitar in a blues band influenced by the Chicago blues style and then in a series of rock 'n roll bands. He started playing electric bass in

a country band in the 1970's. Jay claims his country band played in clubs that should have had chicken wire in front of the stage. He spent one cold fall weekend playing outdoors at the Watkins Glen Grand Prix with gloves on his hands. Jay started playing upright bass in the 1970's with a church choir and soon joined a bluegrass band.

With Don and Cindy, Jay's bass playing ranges from a minimal definition of the chord progression to a jazzy walking bass style. He's been accompanying Don and Cindy Roy for many years in a variety of bands including The Maine French Fiddlers. At times it's hard to distinguish Jay's bass playing from Cindy's left hand rhythms on the piano. Jay claims he has a psychic connection and knows what Cindy is going to play before she plays it.

Performances by the Don Roy Trio in 2004 included the Library of Congress and the Kennedy Center in Washington DC. Previous concerts include Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, Merkin Concert Hall, The Barns at Wolf Trap, 2 appearances with Garrison Keillor and 2 performances at the National Folk Festival to name a few.
